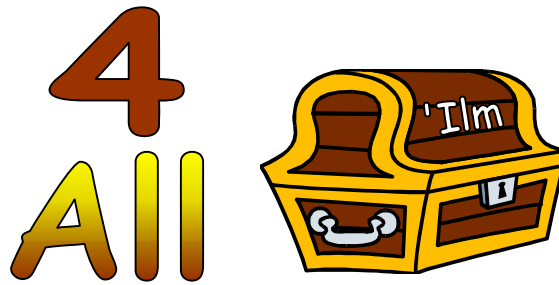


# Scholarly Treasures



## The Greatest Danger Before Any Other Danger

The noble scholar Muhammad Ibn Saalih al-'Uthaymeen *rahimahullaah* said: <sup>1</sup>

"The most serious of all that Allaah forbade is *Shirk* and this is because the greatest of all rights are the Rights of Allaah the Mighty and Majestic.

So if a person violates the Right of Allaah, then he has violated the greatest of all Rights which is the *Tawheed* of Allaah..."

The noble scholar Saalih Ibn Fawzaan Aali-Fawzaan *hafihahullah* said:<sup>2</sup>

"...as long as you have understood *Tawheed* which is to single out Allaah alone for worship, then it is obligatory upon you to recognise *Shirk* because the one who does not know something, falls into it..."

So the danger of *Shirk* is that it prohibits entry into Paradise...

*Therefore it is a great danger which is obligatory for you to have knowledge of, before any other danger..."*
